Market Court is a small, vibrant new public space in downtown Los Angeles. Formerly a parking lot, the space has been transformed into an outdoor terrace for the historic Grand Central Market, while maintaining truck access to the market's loading docks behind. The popular gathering place serves as an urban crossroads between the office towers of Bunker Hill and the street life of Broadway. The project was designed by Suisman Urban Design with Meléndrez Associates for the MTA and the Yellin Company. The Downtown

News has praised it as "modest but full of virtues." In 2001, Market Court received a design award from the Los Angeles Business Council.
